In that the past secretary, Ruth Ensing, has resigned, no meeting minutes not yet approved will be missing, as the minutes have not been submitted.


The CAC had invited both the FD & PD to the meeting to share information obtained in the area of "lock box program" and "prescription drug turn in program". Due to scheduling conflicts, neither department was able to attend. Information will be shared with the departments in letter form from CAC Chairman. The drug turn in program was discussed by the CAC last year, however; apparently no action was taken by the council to share the information with the FD or PD.

The lock box program information obtained by members Bill Sullivan is one that is currently in place in DuPage County. The cost is \$30. Per box compared to the current program cost, which exceeds \$100.


Members present discussed the continued lack of attendance by commission members. It is difficult to conduct meetings without member input.
