



Storage of Boats, Recreational Vehicles, and Trailers

Classification Key

Class I Vehicle	≤ 26 feet in length	[Red Rectangle]

Class II Vehicle	> 26 feet < 40 feet in length	[Blue Rectangle]
Allowable Location for Storage		[Blue Rectangle]
Class III Vehicle	≥ 40 feet in length	
Allowable Location for Storage	Nowhere on the lot	

Yard Key

[Diagonal Hatching]	Front Yard
[Vertical Hatching]	Interior Side Yard
[Cross Hatching]	Rear Yard
[Grid Hatching]	Corner Side Yard

Additional Specifications

- 1) Must be stored on a hard surface (excludes gravel, unless existing). Wheels may be located on four pavers/concrete blocks in the rear yard only.
- 2) Maximum of 2 per lot. Vehicles stored within a garage do not count towards the 2 maximum. Two vehicles stored on a single trailer shall count as 1 vehicle.
- 3) All vehicles must be operable.
- 4) No vehicle may be used for living, sleeping or housekeeping purposes.
- 5) Must have proper registration displayed.
- 6) May not encroach onto sidewalks or other areas of public right-of-way.
- 7) Special provisions apply for trip preparation, see Section 17.40.050 of the Zoning Ordinance.

All of the above regulations have been provided as a summary of the City of Oak Forest's Zoning Ordinance. If at any time, the above regulations are in conflict with Title 17 of the Oak Forest Municipal Code, Title 17 shall act as the correct regulations.
