



TEMPORARY SIGNAGE GUIDE

DAILY ALLOWED TEMPORARY SIGNS (No Permit Required)

A-Frame Signage: Allowed 1 total with 6 square feet maximum in area per side (12 SF total) & displayed during business operating hours only - Must be on subject property and out of right-of-way with no visual impairments. May not be used in conjunction with a sign walker or feather sign(s).

Feather Signs: 1 per 50 feet of frontage on business property and displayed only during business operating hours only. May not be used in conjunction with a sign walker or an A-Frame.

Sign Walker: Allowed 1 total with mandated shift periods of 6:00 a.m. to 8:00 a.m., 11:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m., and 5:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. Must be on business property or public sidewalk during allotted times. May not be used in conjunction with an A-Frame sign or a



TEMPORARY SIGNS (Banners, Yard Signs, Etc.)

Besides otherwise mentioned in this guide, all other temporary signs require a temporary sign permit. Temporary signage can be displayed for a maximum of 30 days non-consecutively 4 times a year. At least 14 days must lapse from the end of one permit until the beginning of a new permit. All temporary signs must be securely affixed while displayed. Sizing requirements may vary for particular temp signs. Please contact the building/zoning department for size requirements.



PRE-OPENING OR GRAND OPENING SIGNAGE

1 temp wall sign maximum of 32 square feet and 1 temp ground sign maximum of 16 square feet on 1 side (total 32 SF). A business may advertise for two time periods: 1. 90 days prior to opening ("Coming Soon!") or 2. 90 days after the open of the business. Ground signs must be on subject property and out of right-of-way with no visual impairments.
