**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 151.006
ADOPTION OF ILLINOIS PLUMBING CODE**

WHEREAS, the City of Oak Forest is an Illinois municipal corporation organized and operated under the laws of the State of Illinois; and

WHEREAS, the City of Oak Forest is a home rule municipality as defined by Article VII of the Illinois Constitution; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to revise the Municipal Code as it relates to adoption of the Illinois Plumbing Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OAK FOREST, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

SECTION 1: That Section 151.006 of the Municipal Code concerning Plumbing Codes adopted is deleted in its entirety and replaced in lieu thereof with the following:

That a certain document, three copies of which are on file in the office of the City Clerk of the City of Oak Forest, being marked and designated as the Illinois Plumbing Code, be and is adopted as the Plumbing Code of the City of Oak Forest, providing for the issuance of permits and the collection of fees thereof; and each and all of the regulations, provisions, penalties, collections and terms of the Plumbing Code on file in the Office of the City Clerk of the City of Oak Forest are referred to, adopted and made a part hereof, as if fully set out in this subchapter with the additions, insertions, deletions, and changes, if any, prescribed below.

SECTION 2: Adopted. The Illinois State Plumbing Code, current edition, issued by the Illinois Department of Public Health. Three copies of the codes shall be kept on file in the City Clerk's office for public inspection.

SECTION 3: Amendments to the Illinois State Plumbing Code. The Illinois State Plumbing Code, current edition, is hereby amended as they apply within the City of Oak Forest as follows:

- (a) Pursuant to 17 Ill. Admin. Code 3730.307(c)(4) and subject to the Illinois Plumbing Code (77 Ill. Admin. Code 890) and the Lawn Irrigation Contractor and Lawn Sprinkler System Registration Code (77 Ill. Admin. Code 892), be it hereby ordained that in the City of Oak Forest, all new and replacement plumbing fixtures and irrigation controllers installed after the effective date of this ordinance shall bear the WaterSense label (as designated by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency WaterSense Program), when such labeled fixtures are available.
- (b) In Section 890.1190 (b), the first sentence shall be deleted in its entirety and substituting in lieu thereof the following: “The utility meter (i.e. the water meter) shall be installed within the building.”
- (c) Section 890.1200 (a) shall be amended to read: Water service piping sizing. The water service pipe from the street main (including the tap) to the water distribution system for the building shall be at least one inch in diameter, Type K, copper.
- (d) Section 890. Appendix A: Approved Building Drainage/Vent Pipe. The approved materials are the following items:

2) Brass Pipe, 3) Cast Iron Pipe, 5) Copper/Copper Alloy Pipe, 6) Copper/Copper Alloy Tubing (K-L-M or DWV), 7) Galvanized Steel Pipe, 8) Glass Fiber Borosilicate Pipe, 9) High Silicone Content Cast Iron Pipe, 11) Polyvinyl Chloride (PVC) Pipe and Fittings, 14) Solder, 15) Stainless Steel – types 304 and 316 L, 16) Stainless Steel Buttweld Fittings, 17) Stainless Steel Flanges, 18) Identification of Piping Systems. Delete items; 1, 4, 10, 12 and 13.

(e) Section 890. Appendix A: Approved Materials for Building Sewer. The approved materials are the following items:

7) Polyvinyl Chloride (PVC) Pipe, Specifically: SDR 26 PVC (Green) AWWA C900 (Blue) ASTM D2241 (White)

12) Identification of Piping Systems

Delete items: 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 8, 9, 10 and 11.

(f) Section 890. Appendix A: Approved Materials For Water Service Pipe. The approved materials are the following items: 3) Cast Iron (Ductile Iron) Water Pipe, approved for commercial use only for pipes greater than 2 inches, 6) Copper/ Copper Alloy Tubing – Type K

Delete items: 1, 2, 4, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, and 15.

(g) Section 890. Appendix A: Approved Materials for Water Distribution Pipe. The approved materials are the following items: 1) Brass Pipe, 3) Copper/Copper Alloy Pipe,

- 4) Copper/Copper Alloy Tubing, 6) Galvanized Steel Pipe, 10) Stainless Steel Pipe, 11) Welded Copper Water Tube, 12) Solder. Delete items: 2, 5, 7, 8 and 9.
- (h) Section 890.310 shall be amended to add at the end of the section the following words: "All copper water tubing, when installed underground shall be a minimum of Type K, and when above grade shall be a minimum of Type L."
- (i) Section 890.330(c) shall be amended to delete the reference to CPVC for potable water applications.
- (j) Section 890.340 f) Copper water tube is to be amended to add the following language at the end of the subsection:
- a. Flared joint adapter shall be required at all water service supply lines two (2) inch or less with full port ball valve upstream of water meter.
 - b. Soldered and/or braised fittings shall not be installed below grade.

SECTION 4: Building sewers.

- (1) Building sewer lines shall conform to the provisions of this code.
- (2) Persons who shall violate a provision of this code or shall fail to comply with any of the requirements thereof or who shall erect, install, alter or repair work in violation of the approved construction documents or directive of the Code Official, or of a permit or certificate issued under the provisions of this code shall be cited and fined not less than \$50 and not more than \$500. Each day can be considered

a separate offense. (Ord. 2008-02-01580, passed 3-11-2008; Am. Ord. 2010-08-03040, passed 8-10-2010; Am. Ord. 2011-02-03290, passed 2-22-2011) Penalty, see § 151.999

SECTION 5: All Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 6: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication, as provided by law.
